Diabetes Outreach have a special interest in the provision of diabetes continuing education. In particular we would like to increase education opportunities for rural, remote and isolated health professionals in South Australia. As a response, we offer an audioconferencing series as an introduction to diabetes for Aboriginal health care workers.

The series includes seven audioconferences offered on a Wednesday afternoon from 3.30pm – 4.30pm, commencing in June and finishing in July. The audioconferences are interactive and presented by experienced health professionals.

## What is it?

Audioconferencing is the linking of individuals or groups in two or more locations using the telephone. It is also a term used interchangeably with teleconferencing or teletutorial, the latter two also referring to links via a television or telephone.

The use of audioconferencing in business and education has been popular because it allows participants to interact while remaining in their own home or workplace. Also, this mode of delivering information and education is more cost effective as it decreases the need for travel and accommodation.

The audioconference is organised by Diabetes Outreach with participants covering their own line costs (standard STD rates apply for rural areas). The external education folder, handouts and administration costs are provided free of charge. We hope you enjoy this experience and look forward to some interesting discussions.
